Fellowship Application Instructions

The Fellowship Application consists of seven parts: (1) a two page form to be completed, (2) attachment of a complete, current *curriculum vita* (CV), (3) <u>three</u> evaluations that should be sent directly to the Program by the evaluators, (4) a project description, and (5) a statement of support from your proposed Mentor (see below), (6) a transcript, and (7) an NIH biosketch and statement of other support from the mentor. Evaluators should use the form, plus continuation pages. At least two of the evaluators should be PI-eligible faculty who are knowledgeable about laboratory-based biomedical investigation. The third evaluator could also be faculty but might instead be a private sector or public sector staff scientist, for example.

Curriculum vita: The current CV should provide the following information:

- Undergraduate college attended, including institution name, location, inclusive dates attended, jamjor and minor discipline(s) studied, and degree(s) received, and any degree distinctions (e.g. Honors Biology, etc.)
- Graduate or professional schools attended, including Institution name, location, years attended, major discipline(s) studied, and degree(s) received
- o Postgraduate training, including Institution name, location, years attended, major disciplines studied, and degree received, if applicable
- Training in the ethical conduct of research
- Honors and awards, including scholarships
- o Publications, and papers or posters presented at professional meetings
- Any previous <u>professional</u> employment; do not include jobs held in student assistance programs or graduate student teaching fellowships/stipends

Project Description: In not more than three pages (exclusive of figures and literature citations), 12 pt font, single spaced with your name in the header on each page, please explain:

 Concise description of your proposed research including (1) specific aims, (2) background and relevant studies, (3) research design, and (4) research experience and career goals

You should contact the proposed Mentor and request that a statement <u>endorsing your</u> <u>candidacy</u> for a fellowship, <u>a commitment to mentoring you</u> if you are accepted into the Program, and a brief outline (no more than 1 page) of the <u>Mentor's training plan for your fellowship</u>. A <u>sample</u> is attached.

Do not propose multiple mentors even though you may identify more than one mentor in whose laboratory you would like to work; however, a Mentor can endorse multiple candidates.
